Your day begins at the birthplace of Calgary - Fort Calgary. From here, we travel to Inglewood, Calgary's first commercial area, and on to other districts that contributed to Calgary's growth, among them Downtown, Chinatown, and Bridgeland.

Stories of the early frontier settlers will be woven throughout the day providing you with insights to their personalities. Your day concludes with a drive through "American Hill", a neighbourhood of Calgary's early influential businessmen.
